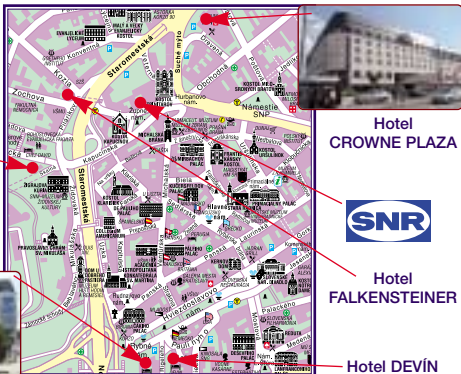
TRANSPORT
