Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF) is an international, independent, medical humanitarian organisation that delivers emergency aid to people affected by armed conflict, epidemics, natural disasters and exclusion from healthcare. MSF offers assistance to people based on need, irrespective of race, religion, gender or political affiliation.

MSF is actively recruiting Medical Doctors, Surgeons, Anesthetists and Gynecologists for our medical aid operations throughout the entire world as well as emergency surgical projects. Working in the field for MSF is a challenge. International fieldwork will give you the possibility to assist people in need in a very constructive and concrete way. Your contribution will be important for our mission, thus also contribute to your own development professionally and personally.

General requirements:

- Degree in Medicine
- Minimum two years of relevant professional experience post-qualification
- Fluency in English; knowledge of French / Arabic is also desirable
- Understanding of and commitment to the <u>Charter of MSF</u>
- Experience in supervising, training and managing others
- Ability to work with limited technical resources
- Willingness to work in potentially unstable environments

Availability requirements:

- Surgeons, Anesthetists & Gynecologists : Availability for a minimum of 2 months
- Medical Doctors: Availability of 9-12 months

Specialty-specific requirements:

- **Medical Doctors:** experience working with HIV or Tuberculosis or any other infectious diseases, or proven experience of working in primary healthcare guards and emergency room.
- **Surgeons**: experience in all types of surgical interventions as well as in Caesarean sections. Experience in performing minor and major surgeries, which are often violence related (e.g. gunshots, spear wounds).
- Anesthetists: Experience in paediatric, obstetric and trauma anesthesia, including anesthesia with
 intubation. Experience in dissociation anaesthesia (e.g. Ketamine). Extensive experience in spinal

- Gynecologists: experience in all types of deliveries, including all complicated cases and Caesarean sections. Experience in elective obstetric/gynaecologic and emergency surgeries as well as in pre and post-operative management (especially fluid and pain management).
